#### Acceptable Use Policy:

Signal West LLC wants to create a network that can be used and enjoyed by all its ISP Service customers. As we hope to keep things running fairly and legally, Signal West has an Acceptable Use Policy. Although much of what is included here is common sense, Signal West takes network management and these issues very seriously and will enforce its rules to ensure enjoyment by all of its members. Signal West reserves the right to suspend or cancel a subscriber's account for engaging in inappropriate conduct; Subscribers, of course, also remain legally responsible for any such acts. In using the service provided by Signal West LLC, subscribers accept this non-exhaustive list of restrictions as well as those set forth in Signal West's Customer Agreement and agree to use the service only for lawful purposes and not to use or allow others to use the ISP Service in violation of the following guidelines:

This service is for single family residence or home-office use only. Internet sharing is allowed only within the boundaries of the residence. Allowing others to use this connection via wired, wireless (WiFi or other technology) or by other means will result in immediate disconnection and any prepaid services for the month will not be refunded. Using a personal account for high volume or commercial use (e.g., revenue generation, advertising, distribution of content etc.) is prohibited.

The service may not be used to engage in any conduct that interferes with Signal West's ability to provide service to others, including the use of excessive bandwidth.

The service may not be used in a manner that interferes with Signal West's efficient operation of its network, facilities, or the ability of others to utilize the ISP Service in a reasonable manner. Signal West may use various tools and techniques to protect the security and integrity of its networks, which may include detecting malicious traffic patterns, preventing the distribution of viruses or other malicious code, and such other tools and techniques as Signal West may from time to time determine appropriate.

In using the ISP Service, you may not use an IP address or client ID not assigned to you, forge any TCP/IP packet header or any part of the header information in an e-mail or newsgroup posting or probe, scan or test the vulnerability of any system or network by the use of sniffers, SNMP tools or any other method.

The ISP Service may not be used to breach or attempt to breach the security, the computer, the software or the data of any person or entity, including Signal West, to circumvent the user authentication features or security of any host, network or account, to use or distribute tools designed to compromise security, or to interfere with another's use of the ISP Service through

the posting or transmitting of a virus or other harmful item to deliberately overload or flood that entity's system.

ISP Services shall not be used to publish, submit/receive, upload/download, post, use, copy or otherwise reproduce, transmit, distribute or store child pornography.

The ISP Service may not be used to upload, post, transmit or otherwise make available any materials or content that violate or infringe on the rights or dignity of others. These include, but are not limited to, materials infringing or compromising intellectual property rights (P2P file sharing of copyright material in any form) or the ability to maintain trade secrets and other personal information as private; threats of physical violence; harassing conduct; sexually oriented material that is offensive or inappropriate; and unsolicited bulk e-mail.

The ISP Service may not be used to engage in or foster any consumer fraud such as illegal gambling, "Make Money Fast" schemes, chain letters, Pyramid, or other investment schemes, or to make or encourage people to accept fraudulent offers by e-mail, USENET or other means, of products, items or services, originating from your account, or through a third party which implicates your account or to post or transmit off-topic or commercial messages on bulletin boards.

You may not engage in any of the above activities using the service of another ISP, while channeling such activities through your ISP Service account or using this account as a mail drop for responses.
